I. WELCOME

Chairman Wayne Moore welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order with a quorum of three (3) directors present at 10:30 a.m.

III. ACTION ITEMS / UPDATES FROM STAFF

1. Tab A – Adoption of Amended YVSA By Laws – Nicole Johnston

- A notice was published for 10 days in the paper.
- Discussion was noted from the August 15th, 2017 meeting.
 - Chairman Moore asked for a motion to approve the Adoption of Amended By-Laws.
 - This motion was made by Director Rheajean Benge and seconded by Vice-Chair J. L. Lowe. The vote was three (3) to zero, in favor with no discussion.

2. Tab B- Update/Discussion on Weyerhaeuser- Gary Stainback

- New preliminary data came in on August 27, 2017, but staff didn't have time to review it.
- August 1, 2017 YVSA had a conversation with ProChem, they provided data that had three (3) different runs, which weren't consistent.
- Three (3) batches of results were ran and, 0.15 MPL is the limit:

- Batch 7 is higher, this is small lab testing, not sure if the water flea can be reproduced inside or outside the lab again. The water flea has to live to reproduce.
- If the sample isn't good then it could be detrimental to our system, and ruin things such as: Pump Stations (PS), Wet wells, pumps, etc.
- The cyanide is over limit, they are adding a peroxide treatment to break that bond.
- Gary spoke to Tom Boehling about having toxicity test results by August 30th, 2017.
- Results gave a general overview of analytical data submitted thus far.
- This data still shows cyanide in their wastewater. They did not respond back by the 21st as he said he would, stated in the email
- It is recommended that YVSA not re-bid on Weyerhaeuser because the bid would be higher.
- It is the county's project they will decide to re-bid or not.
- The Gilbert Engineering deadline price is on hold until September 1st, 2017, although it will probably go past that about 1 week or 1 month or could even go until mid-September.
- Price will more than likely increase on material, anywhere from 5% but less than 10% increase.
